Purpose

To publish updated poverty guideline tables

The attached tables reflect the 100% and 200% Poverty Income Guidelines for 2009. This Technical Advisory renders TA # 08-2, issued February 4, 2008, obsolete.

Background

The United States Department of Health and Human Services published Poverty Income Guidelines for 2009 in the January 23, 2009 edition of the Federal Register.

These guidelines go into effect on the day they are published unless an office administering a program using the guidelines specifies a different effective date for that particular program.

Poverty Guidelines are used to determine low income eligibility for WIA, tax credits and Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) eligibility. For information about how the poverty guidelines are used or how income is defined in a particular program, contact the Federal (or other) office which is responsible for that program.
